

INAUGURAL WINDSOR ROGUES ANNUAL CRICKET DAY

Rules & Match Play

1. Each team requires 8 players and must have 1 expat (or knowledgeable cricket player) as the captain
2. Each game will go for 17 overs
 - a. Each player must bowl 2 overs each with one allowed to bowl 3 overs
3. Players are to retire when they reach 30 runs.
 - a. If a player scores more than thirty runs on the scoring shot that takes them past 30, all additional runs will count towards the individual and team total
 - b. If the team is bowled out, retired players may return to the crease based on order of retirement and bat until they are out.
4. The batsman is out when:
 - a. They are clean bowled
 - b. Caught on the full from a regulation bowl
 - c. Stumped
 - d. Hit Wicket
 - e. Run out
 - f. Leg Before Wicket (LBW), only when the player does not offer a shot and is absolutely plum
5. Bowlers cannot come off more than 6 steps
6. Batting team must supply a stump umpire and square leg umpire
7. There are no field restrictions
8. All no balls will be in effect
 - a. Front foot
 - b. Full toss above the waist
 - c. Bouncer above the shoulder
 - d. Bowler breaking the wicket
 - e. Bounces more than twice
9. No balls will result in two runs going to the batting teams total and the bowler required to re-bowl the delivery
10. All wides will be in effect
 - a. Outside the white marking on offside
 - b. Anything halfway between the onside white marking and the stumps
11. The number of team's entered will dictate the tournament structure
 - a. If four teams:
 - i. Game 1 – 1 vs 4
 - ii. Game 2 – 2 vs 3
 - iii. Final game – Winner of game 1 vs winner of game 2
 - b. If three teams:
 - i. Game 1 – 1 vs 3

ii. Game 2 – 1 vs 2

iii. Game 3 – 2 vs 3

1. The winner will be the team with the most wins. If it is a tie, it will be the team that won by the most. If it is still a tie, it will be the team with the higher run rate.
